Fund	Eligibility Criteria	Further Information
Access To Learning Fund (ALF)	The fund is open to both Undergraduate and Postgraduate students who have 'home' fee status and is in place to help students experiencing financial hardship. In addition to having 'home' fee status, students applying for support must be able to evidence that they have applied for/are in receipt of the full support available to them through Student Finance England. Students who choose not to accept any source of funding available to them will not be eligible to apply for support through the Access To Learning Fund. <i>Payments are based on attendance and progression</i>	Up to £1000 paid in three instalments throughout the year
Short-Term Loan	This fund is available to Higher Education Students who are not going to receive their loan on time. The loan is designed to help students in financial hardship in the interim, until your student finance comes through.	Up to £500
Lincolnshire and Yorkshire & Humber Institute of Technologies Quickline Bursary 2024/2025	This Bursary fund provides the flexibility for IoT training providers to support the removal of any barriers that are preventing students and apprentices from enrolling, attending, fully participating, and successfully achieving a course at an IoT training provider. To qualify you must be enrolled as a student on a Lincolnshire or the Yorkshire and the Humber Institute of Technologies listed program, be aged 18 or above, reside in an eligible postcode area and study on an IoT course at Level 4/5. If there is a low number of eligible students' further criteria will be added, and additional applications may be accepted from Level 3 and 6 students	Up to £1000
Care Experienced Bursary	Our Care Experienced Bursary offers an award to registered students who are currently in, or have previously been in, the care of a Local Authority for any length of time and at any stage in their life. This includes adopted children who were previously in care.	£500 one off payment
Initial Teacher Education (ITE) Bursary (Department of Education)	Aimed at PGCE students, studying to work in FE, it is available for the following subjects; Computing, Engineering or manufacturing, Mathematics, Science, English (capped at 100 places) Special educational needs and disabilities (SEND) Scan the QR code to see requirements.
